Conditions of play and Qualifications

1. Conditions of Play

The Championship shall be foursomes stroke play over 36 holes.
The winners shall be the pair who return the lowest scratch score over 36 holes.
The attention of all competitors is drawn the General Conditions relating to all Union Championships and Tournaments.
60 pairs will be eligible to compete.

2. Prizes and Vouchers

The winners shall hold The Championship Cup until the next Championship.
In the event of a tie for the Championship the winners shall be decided by a 'sudden death' play-off.
Depending on the number of entries both gross and net First, Second, Third and Fourth prizes will be awarded. Apart from the winners of the Championship, ties for other prizes will be decided on the basis of the last 18, 9, 6, 3, etc holes.

3. Qualification

To be eligible to enter a player must:

- Be in possession of a CONGU active playing handicap **not exceeding 16** and the maximum handicap of a pair **shall not exceed 31**.
- Have been born in the county or have been a member of a GGU affiliated club for at least twelve months immediately prior to the date of the meeting.
- Not have competed for the Championships of any other County Union since January 1st of the previous calendar year.

4. Entries

Entries to the Championship should be sent to the County Secretary to reach him before Noon on 14th June 2010, together with an entry fee of £25.00 per pair (cheques to be made payable to the Gloucestershire Golf Union). Order of Play and Starting Times will not be sent to competitors but will be sent to the Secretaries of Competitors' Clubs. Where entries exceed 60 there will be a ballot amongst the highest handicap pairs to reduce the entries to that number. Once the draw is made no refunds of entry fees will be returned.

5. Driving Clubs

'Driving Clubs' must not have a characteristic time greater than 257 microseconds when measured on pendulum testing apparatus approved by R&A Rules Ltd. See also Appendix 11-5a of the Rules of Golf.

6. Distance Measuring Devices (DMDs)

DMDs may be used in all county events only if the DMD is not designed to gauge or measure other conditions that may affect play, e.g. gradient, windspeed, temperature, direction etc. See rule 14.3.

Penalty for breach of condition – Disqualification.
