## The Gloucestershire County Junior Champion Club Tournament 2010 (Qualifying for the English Junior Champion Club Finals at Malton & Norton on 21/22 August 2010) Played at Cotswold Hills Golf Club on Friday 2nd April 2010 Current holders Cotswold Hills Golf Club

### Conditions of Play and Qualification

#### 1. Conditions of Play

- a The championship shall be played over 36 holes by individual nett stableford.
- b Each Club team shall consist of 3 players (Boys, Girls or Mixed).
- c The winning Club shall be the Club with the highest aggregate stableford score over 36 holes, taking the best 2 scores out of 3 each round. In the event of a tie the third stableford score for each round will be taken and decided on the 36-hole aggregate total.
- d If a tie still arises the result shall be decided on the highest stableford score for the second 18 holes or 9 or 6 or 3 or 1 taking all three scores into account. Thereafter the score for the first 18-holes shall be treated in the same way until a decision is reached.
- e **Caddies are not permitted.**  
(Penalty for breach of condition 1e. 2 points for each hole at which the breach occurred. Maximum penalty per round – 4 points.)

#### 2. Prizes

- a The winning Club shall be the County Junior Champions and will receive a trophy to hold for the year. Mementos or vouchers shall be awarded to members of the winning team and second placed teams
- b The winning Club will be invited to send a team to represent Gloucestershire in the EGU Junior Champion Club Tournament over 36 holes at Malton & Norton 21/22 August 2010. The winning Club will receive some financial assistance towards the cost of the weekend accommodation from the County.

#### 3. Qualification

- a Each affiliated GLCGA/GGU Club shall be eligible to enter **up to 2 teams** to compete in the tournament. **The cost of each entry shall be £20 per team of 3.**
  - b The choice of team selection shall be at the discretion of the Club.
  - c The maximum playing handicap shall be 24 for boys and 36 for girls and must be a CONGU 'active' handicap.
- In addition each member of the team must:
- d Be under 18 years on 1st January in the year the championship takes place.
  - e Be a current member of the Club they represent.
  - f Have nominated the Club as her/his Home Club for handicapping purposes.
  - g Have been eligible to compete in either the Girls or Boys County Championship irrespective of any handicap limits imposed by the County.
  - h Not have played for any other Club **in any competitive event** during the current season within the County in which the Club is affiliated.
